### Higher Order Questions

- What language(s) do you speak?
- What language(s) does your family speak?

### Assessment of Objective

- Students will be able to say "hello" in a few different languages.

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## "Different Languages"

### Lesson Sequence

#### 1. Read Aloud: (7-9 minutes)

- Read Lisa Bullard's book, *My Language, Your Language*
  - Either read the story aloud, or use [this link](#) to view a video read-aloud!

#### 2. "My Language, Your Language" Coloring Sheet: (10-12 minutes)

- Students will color in the multiple variations of "Hello" in different languages on the sheet.
  - Students will color in the words on the page to familiarize themselves with the appearance of the words and word phrases.
    - *Students have been exposed to some of the languages from the book, but be sure to circulate and talk to them about what they are seeing*
- Students will practice the words on their worksheet in a "call and response" activity.
  - Teacher will demonstrate the pronunciation of the word, and students will repeat it back.
    - *Feel free to pose questions like:*
      - "What language do you speak at home?"
      - "Do you know any other ways to say 'hello'? If so, what's another way?"

#### 3. Wrap Up: (2-3 minutes)

- Encourage students to continue to learn new ways to say "hello" in different languages and share with friends and family the words they learned in class!
