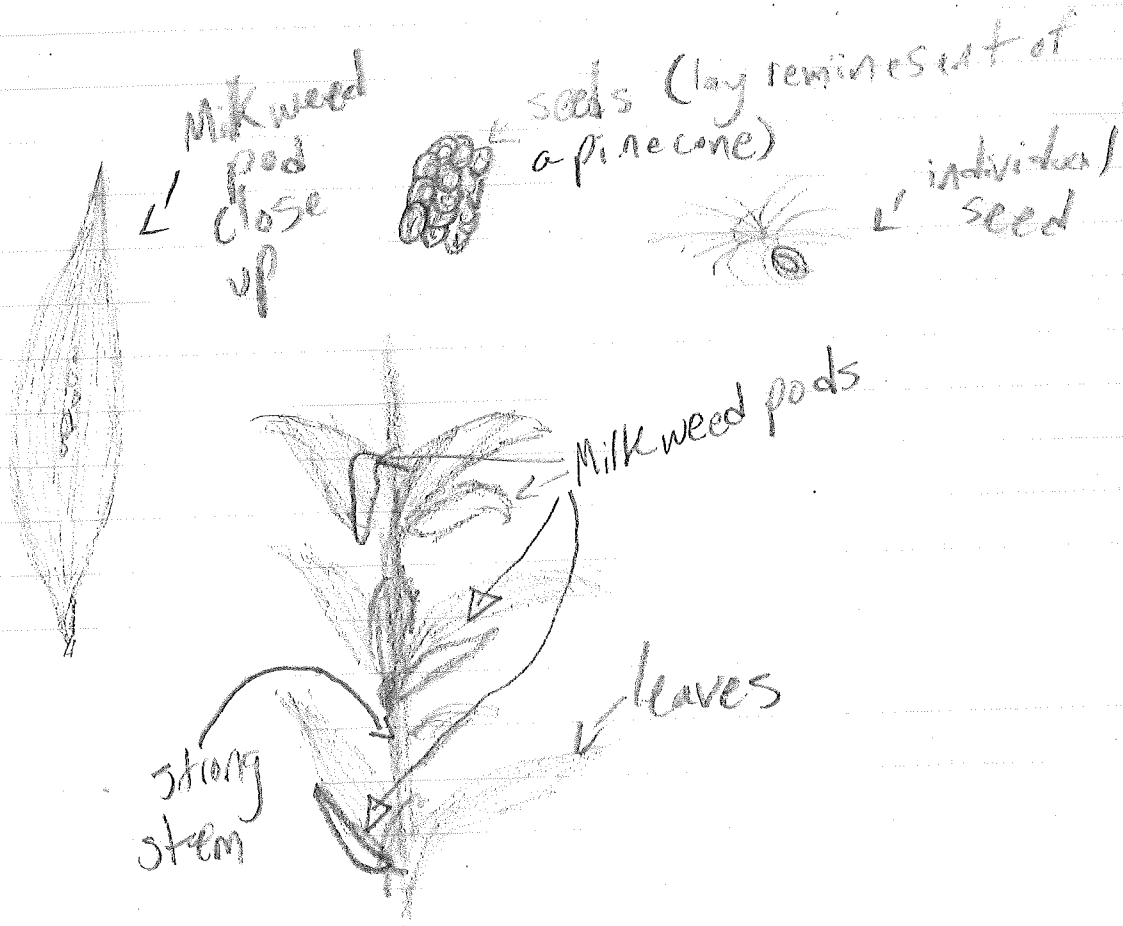


The Common Milkweed plant

10-4-22

This plant can grow to about 6ft with wide, soft but slightly prickly leaves, usually grouped in 2s, spread about an inch apart, and alternating. As these plants age, the leaves yellow, crisp, and eventually fall. These plants are a common food, and nesting place for butterflies. It is native to North America

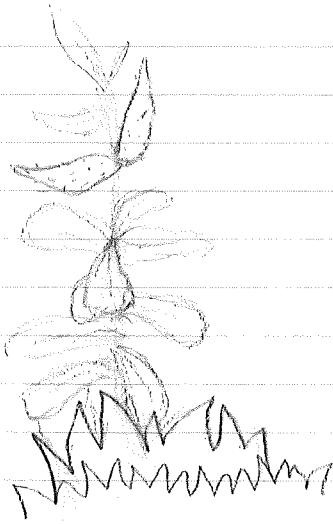


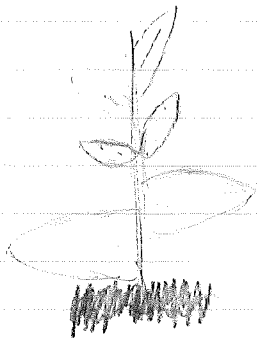


- As this plant has no leaves, has 6 pods

- leaves are pretty big - not alternating

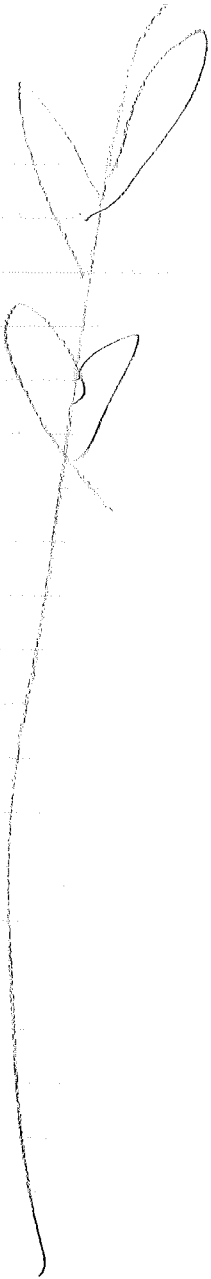

Milkweed is all gone from case, some are still not bloomed. They have a green yellowish color. The casks are pointy.

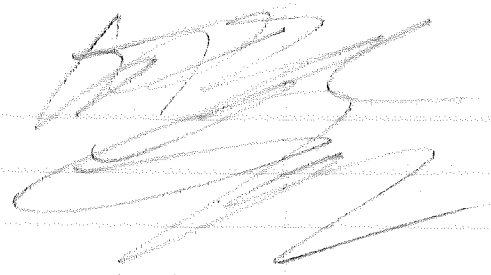
Leaves rough. Some have cracks in the casks.

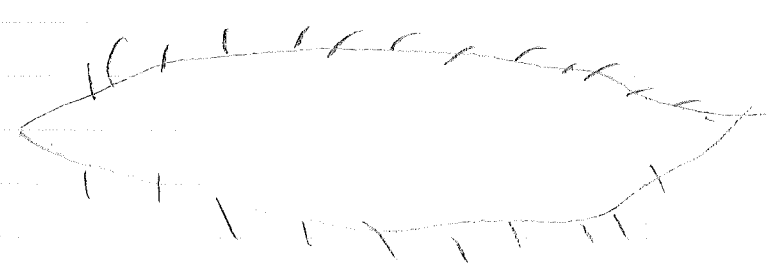

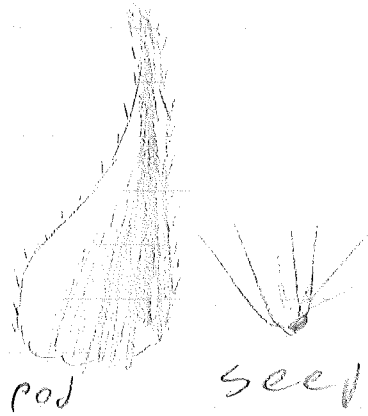
- they can grow tall

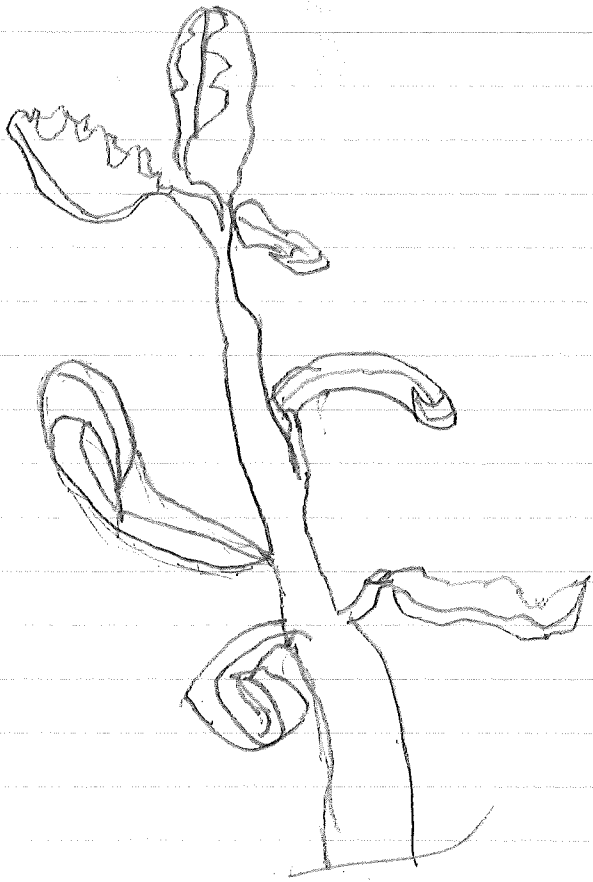

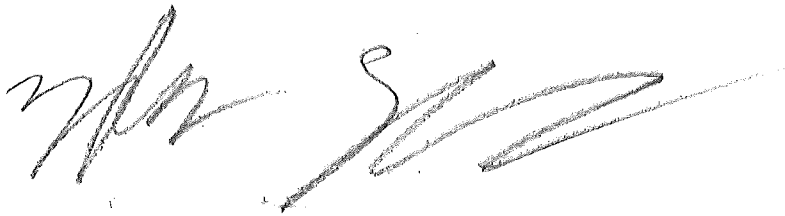

The pods get their own stem, pods
are spiky, the leaves are symmetrical
ends of some leaves are dead,
leaves are white, other plants
are more yellow, pods look like jojoba



- They grow in masses
- Pods develop at the top
- Leaves • Turn yellow in fall
- Leaves fall in fall
- They die and come back each year
- Pods have assorted sizes
- Pods come out several at a time
- Pods open while on plant
- Pods grow off "branches" off of stem
- Stems vary in diameter
- Milkweeds are rarely seen alone
- Creatures eat leaves
- Leaves higher up die first

The stem is a tough thick texture.

Many milkweed seeds grow in a small area

The milkweed change color as they get bigger.

The leaves are larger than the plant
- yellow tinted leaves

They die from the top down of the seed.

When the seed is dead, the white material changes color + shrinks.

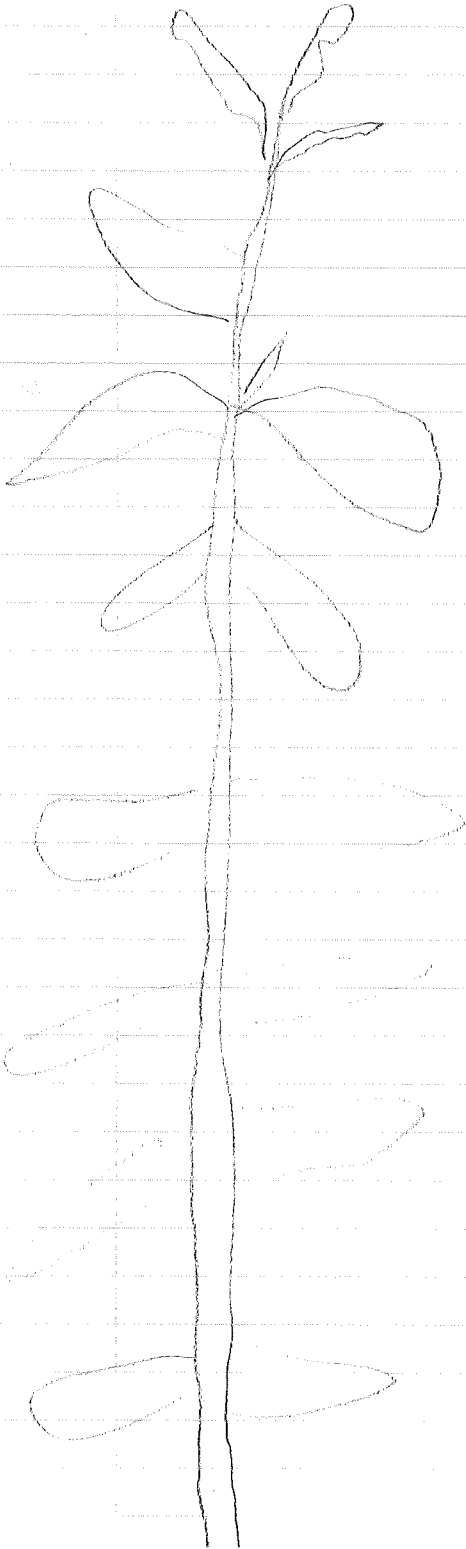

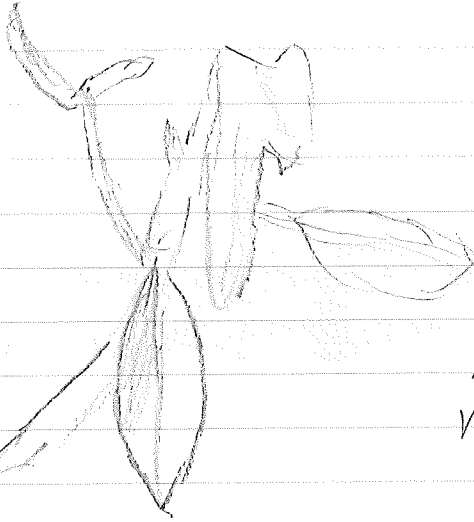

This milk weed appears to ~~not be in the list~~ to be in a state of decay. Many of its leaves are blackened in areas while a large portion of it is a greenish yellow. Its leaning and its leaves are a shriveled oval shape. It does not have pods like the others

20 leaves
2 leaves are dead
other 18 are yellow
the plant has little life left
5 spots - 2 cracked open
Still still - looks rough
leaves grow perpendicular to each other

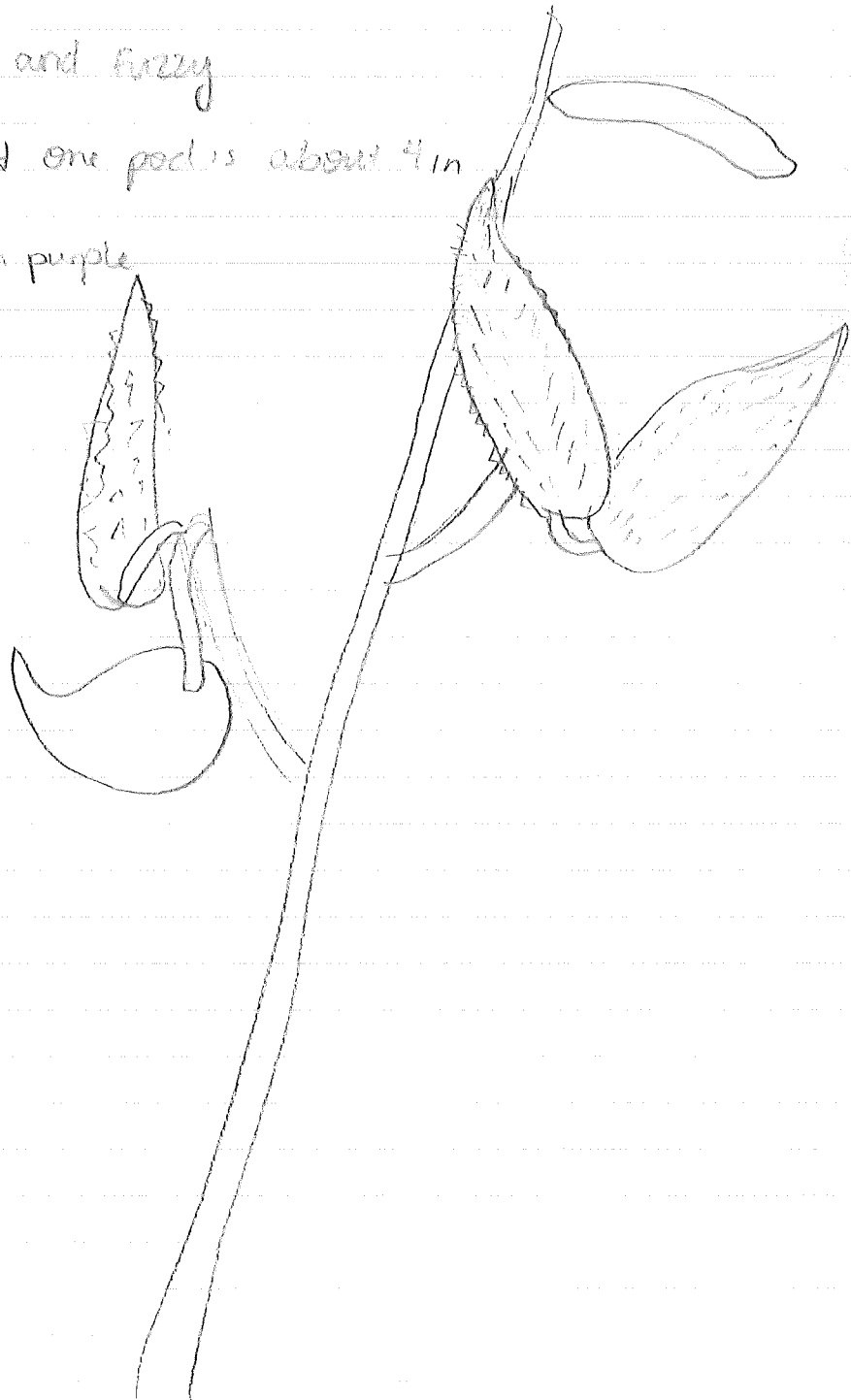
1. It looks pointy but feels soft

2. The plant I looked at has pods grow in pairs or clusters

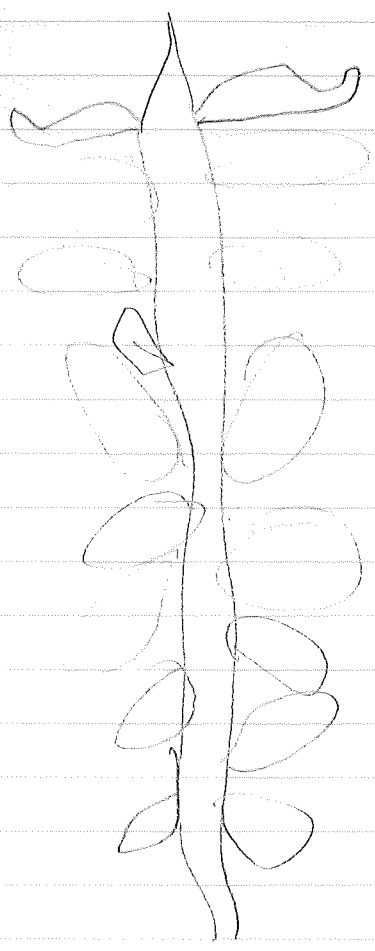

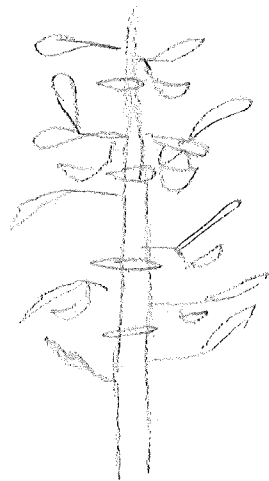
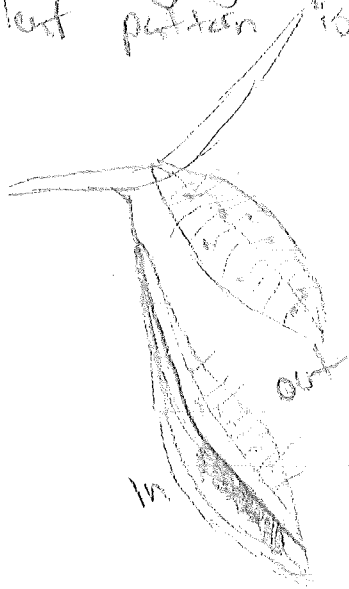


- Many leaves & big seedlings
- Wilting leaves colored ^{mostly green}, yellow, and brown
- leaves are hairy like seedlings
- many bugs on plant
- held up by a tree-like stick
- inside seedlings are very ^{mini} brown seeds
- leaves wilt from top to bottom
- looks like the seedlings shed their cocoon then their seeds fall out / spread
- their leaves are longer than the seedlings

- It has a tough stem
- The pods hang from the stem
- The leaves are green/yellow with spots
- It branches out
- Looks like seeds release when plant dies
- The stem is spotted
- It can grow 6ft +
- The leaves kind of criss cross
- It grows roughly upwards
- The leaf pattern is parallel

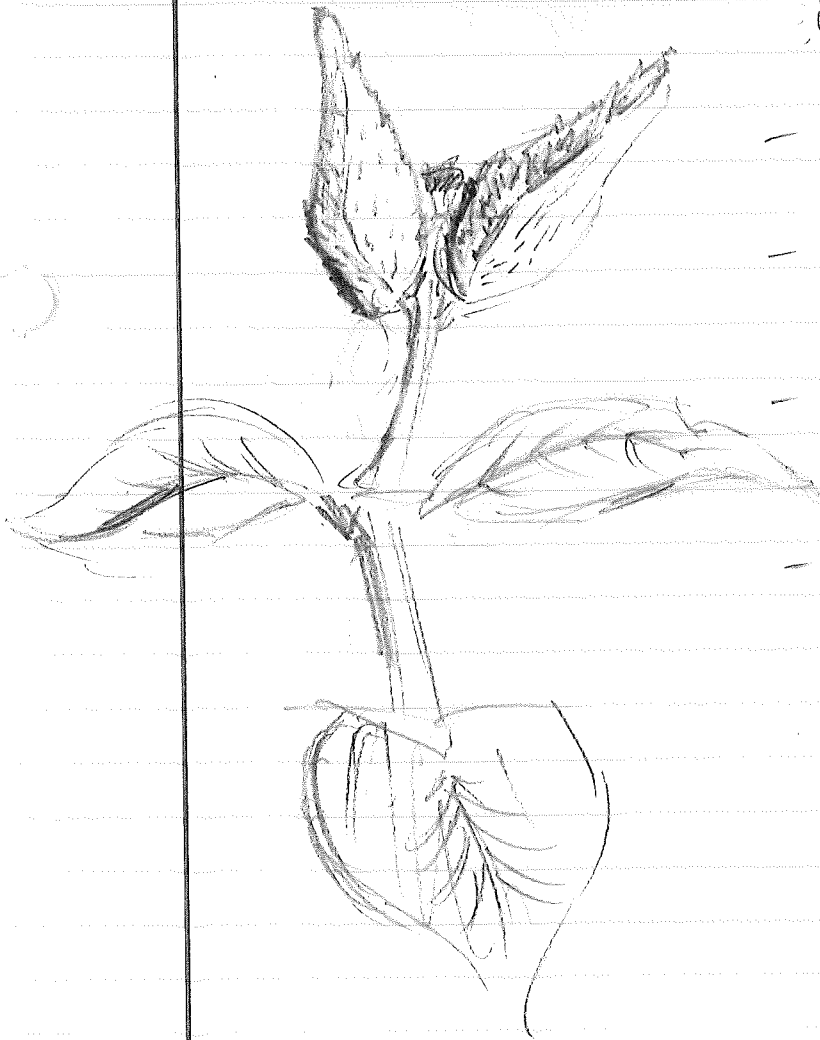
