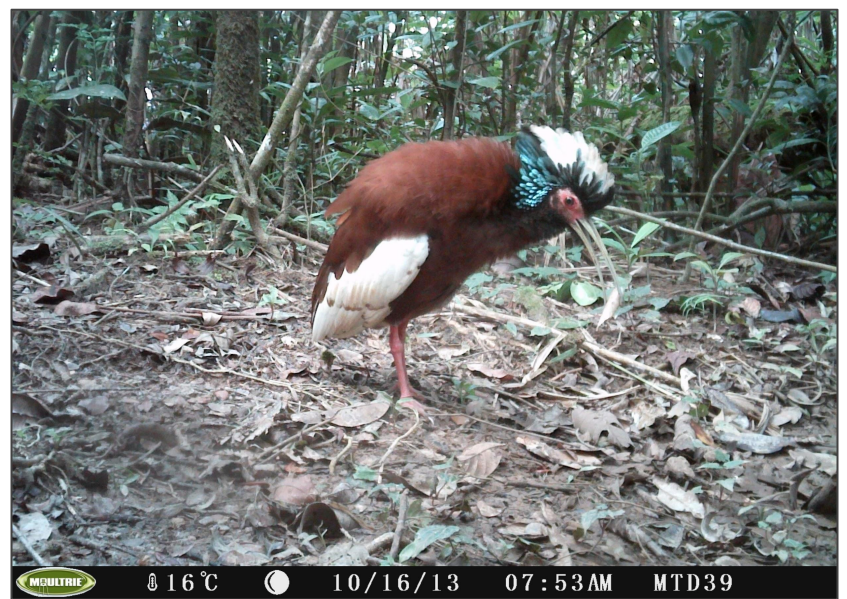
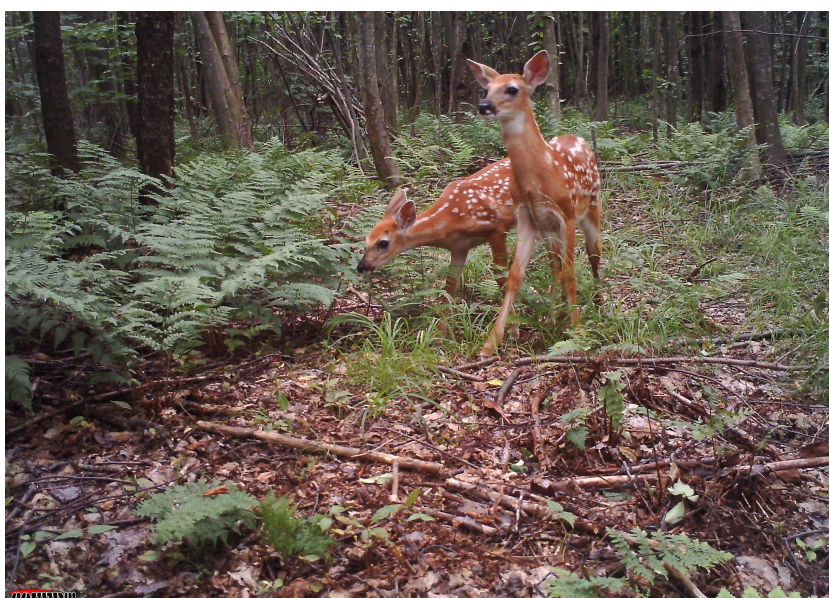
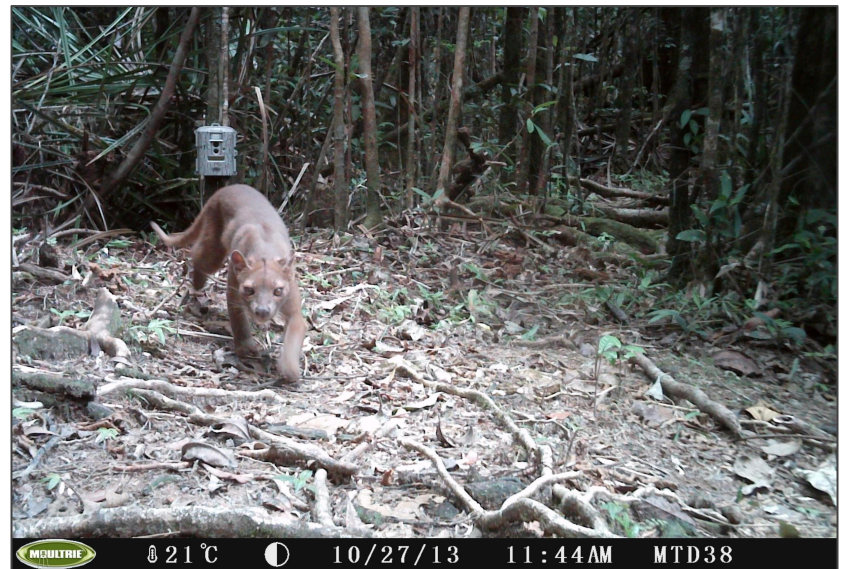


# BIOLOGY SEMINAR:
